B. Establishment of the 2011-2012 School & Library Tax Rates

The tax rate is based on three factors:

1. The amount of money to be raised (tax levy) to fund the District's adopted appropriations budget
2. The taxable assessed value of the properties
3. The proportions in which Homeowners (homestead) and Non-Homeowners (non-homestead) share the cost of the tax levy to be raised. Proportions were established in accordance with the Homestead Tax Option elected by the Town and District in 1988.

Adopted 2011-2012 Budget - The District's adopted 2011-2012 appropriations budget is \$79,570,592, which reflects an increase in appropriations of 2.17% over the prior year's adopted budget.

Tax Levy – represents the adopted appropriations budget less revenue from other sources such as state aid, federal aid, tuition, return of fund balance, etc. The tax

levy to be raised from taxpayers to fund the 2011-2012 adopted budget is \$68,791,474.

Note: The library tax levy of \$225,000 is not included above. This is a separate levy raised through the School District on behalf of the libraries within the Town of Orangetown per voter authorization in prior years.

Taxable Assessed Value of Property – The change in assessments is based on the physical addition/deletion of property from the tax rolls, as well as the reduction in assessments due to tax certiorari settlements for non-homestead parcels and SCAR petitions for homeowners. Homestead taxable assessments decreased by **(\$2,241,547)** and Non-Homestead decreased by **(\$1,825,498)**.

Adjusted Base Proportions – The percentage change in the adjusted base proportions (shift) represents a decrease of **(1.82813%)** for residential property owners (homestead) to 71.82628% from 73.16381% and an increase of 4.98405% for commercial (non-homestead) property owners to 28.17372% from 26.83619%. The decrease in the adjusted base proportion for homestead is directly related to the decrease in market value of homes and the reduction in taxable assessment values (SCAR petitions). The decrease means that the Homeowners share in less of the tax levy burden from the prior year and they actually have a decrease in taxes.

2011-2012 Tax Rates

Residential property owners will bear 71.82628% of the \$68,791,474 tax levy. The tax rate was based on a taxable assessed value of \$1,430,227,823, a decrease of **(\$2,241,547)** from 2010-2011. This results in a 1.89% tax rate increase, which is .29% less than the tax increase estimated during budget development, for a \$34.547193 rate per \$1,000 assessed value. The tax rate increase of 1.89% translates into a tax dollar increase based on the value of the assessment placed on the tax rolls for an individual parcel. Assessments do not represent the fair market value of a residence. The fair market value of a home will typically be much greater than what is reflected on the tax rolls due to equalization rates not being at 100%. For 2011 the equalization rate is 50.50%.

An example of tax dollar increases, not including the effects of the State's STAR Program, based on different assessment values are as follows:

The State's STAR Program: *Basic STAR Exemption is \$35,740, an increase of \$3,250 or 10%. However, the State adopted Budget limits the savings to a maximum increase over the prior year exemption to 2%. As a result, the Basic STAR exemption for 2011-2012 will be \$1,124, \$111 less than what would have been allowed in previous years. Enhanced STAR for seniors is limited to \$2,251. The net result to taxpayers will be a further reduction in the tax increase from what is reflected above. The District also provides other exemptions that are income related.*

Commercial property owners will bear 28.17372% of the \$68,791,474 tax levy. The tax rate was based on a taxable assessed value of \$373,745,668, a decrease of (\$1,825,498) from 2010-11. This results in a 9.32% tax rate increase to \$51.856433, per \$1,000 of assessed value.
