Criteria for Current Seventh Graders

- Students must have earned High or Exceptional Honors for all four quarters in their sixth grade year.
- It is recommended that students have earned in the first three quarters of their seventh grade at least two quarters of High Honors and one quarter of Exceptional Honors. However, a minimum average of 92 (as specified in the Student Organizer) is acceptable provided students have earned at least High Honors for each of those three quarters.
- Five hours of school or community service or involvement is required. This may include participation, attendance or working at school games, concerts, plays, Science Olympiad, Math Counts, volunteer work at charitable organizations, etc. An advisor/supervisor's signature is required.
- A written self evaluation is required. In this essay students are to:

Describe how on a daily basis you serve as a role model of the Three B's –

1. Be Prepared
2. Be Respectful
3. Be Responsible

The essay is to be typed and limited to 150 words.
